The Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) recently evaluated your company's friction measuring system for accreditation as a "Continuous Friction Measuring Equipment" (CFME) for airports.

Our review has found that the Halliday RT3-FAA-Model: 1000 meets the performance standards specified in FAA Advisory Circular 5320-12, *Measurement, Construction, and Maintenance of Skid-Resistant Airport Pavement Surfaces*, and is therefore qualified to function as a CFME for airports.

The RT-3 will be listed in the list of approved CFME shown in Appendix 4 of the AC during the next scheduled revision of the document.
